Hardball Capital, the group bringing a professional team to Columbia's new baseball stadium at the Bull Street development, *Spirit Communications Park*, for the 2016 season, has received the required approval from professional baseball organizations.

Team owner Jason Freier said a letter of approval received by the city of Columbia was a requirement of his group's contract with the city.

Barton Malow, which has extensive experience building ballparks nationally, will head a joint venture that includes three Columbia-area companies: Contract Construction, Construction Dynamics and ENVIRO AgScience.

On January 6, city officials, Hardball Capital, and business leaders broke ground at the Columbia Common site to begin work on Spirit Communications Park.

The state-of-the-art multi-use sports and entertainment venue will be home to an affiliated professional Minor League Baseball team beginning in April, 2016.



Team ENVIRO Atlanta JV named as one of City of Atlanta's Managing General Contractors


